#### PRIMARY REGISTRATION 2021-22

Parents of students entering Grade Primary in September 2021 are asked to pre-register their child as soon as possible. Staffing for next year will be looked at shortly and we need accurate numbers of incoming students in primary. Eligible students must be five years of age on or before December 31, 2021. Parents/Guardians will be required to present identification for their child with the following: child's birth certificate, health card number and expiry date, and proof of residence (i.e.: driver's license, utility bill). Students attending New Ross Consolidated School must live within its catchment area and reside with their legal guardian(s).
